American Quilter's Society commits to three-year run at Convention Center & other area venues

(Lancaster, PA) American Quilter's Society (AQS) president Meredith Schroeder today announced that AQS will unveil its latest show to an anticipated 17,000 attendees at the new Lancaster County Convention Center (LCCC) on March 24-27, 2010.

The *AQS Quilt Show & Contest – Lancaster* will feature nationally-renowned quilting exhibits, workshops, contests, and special events. It's slated to return to Lancaster in both 2011 and 2012.
